

# Cullipool: Beach Feed & Adaptation

## Overview:

This project is Phase 2 of the Cullipool Beach Nourishment programme which will deliver adaptation of the shoreline at Cullipool and ongoing protection to the conservation village. This adaptation is designed to mitigate damage from storm events and flooding, using available matching, locally available resources (slate spoil). Phase 2 continues the work delivered in 2023 to strengthen the north end of the shore protection by completing the more complex south end build and preparing for the main Beach nourishment Phase.

## What we are hoping to learn:

There is learning here for other community groups that have rocky shoreline, suffering erosion and flooding and where local materials are available to reduce the time and costs of mitigation. Also, how communities can use their own resources to deliver agreed community plans for long term action to protect or adapt their coastlines. This is key in the slate islands and nearby mainland coastal areas.
