Overview:

The purpose of this project is to assist in the recharge of shingle along the west beach at Kingston. The recharge is to be designed to act as a feed of shingle while erosions take place. It is anticipated that this would reduce the rate of erosion and provide needed shingle to the SSSI/SAC without using imported material from outwith of the sediment catchment.

What are the project aims:

- Shingle store which self regulates and recharges as erosion happens.
- Trial to determine if this can be implemented along approx. 1km of coastline.
- Prevent further demolition rubble from entering the SSSI/SAC.
- Reopen fenced off areas of coastline to the community.
- Use of shingle from within local area.
